Accepted	NOT Accepted
Prescription medications, including prescribed controlled substances (DEA Schedule II – V).	Marijuana
Over-the-counter medications.	Illicit drugs (Ex. DEA Schedule I drugs like heroin, LSD, etc).
Liquid medications (small amounts in original, non-leaking containers).	Needles, syringes, and other sharps. (Summit County Justice Center accepts these items)
Medicated patches	Chemotherapy drugs.
Medication samples.	Medical tools and supplies or any medication wastes generated by health care facilities, including nursing homes.
Medicated ointments.	Bloody or infectious waste.
Vitamins & Pet medications.	Personal care products. (Summit County Justice Center accepts these items)
Unused drug injection cartridges. (Ex. Unused EpiPens and insulin pens – must be unused with needle still protected inside).	Thermometers.
