## COMPOST USE \& INSTRUCTIONS

Sod Preparation - Blend compost with existing soil. Use between 3 cubic yards per 1000 square feet ( 1 " thick) to a maximum of 6 cubic yards per 1000 square feet ( 2 " thick). Roto-till soil, disc, or manually blend this layer of compost with 6 " of existing soil. It is best to mix soil first, then apply compost, then mix compost and loosened soil again.
Seed Bed Preparation - Blend compost with existing soil. Use between 1-1/2 cubic yards per 1000 square feet ( $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ thick) to a maximum of 3 cubic yards per 1000 square feet ( 1 " thick). Rototill, disc, or manually blend this layer of compost with 6 " of existing soil. It is best to mix soil first, then apply compost, then mix compost and loosened soil again.
Backfilling Trees - one part of compost with 3 parts of native soil and backfill around root ball.
Vegetable Gardens \& Flower
Beds - Blend compost with existing soil. Use between 3 cubic yards per 1000 square feet ( 1 " thick) to a maximum of 6 cubic yards per 1000 square feet (2" thick). Rototill, disc, or manually blend this layer of compost with 6 " of existing soil. It is best to mix soil first, then apply compost, then mix compost and loosened soil again.
Bedding Plants - Spread $1 / 8$ to $1 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ of compost evenly on top of soil, mix into the soil, and then water thoroughly.
House Plants - Spread 1 tablespoon per 6 " pot or about $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ of compost evenly over the top of the soil and water. Repeat every six months or when required.
