SUCCESS DESPITE LESS

Every year, our produce helps feed families in need. Our dedicated farmers work hard to grow as much produce as possible, but some seasons cooperate more than others. Despite this year's harvest being slightly down with 1,383 pounds available for sharing, we were still able to provide fresh produce to 271 families.

REACHING THE WHOLE FAMILY

WIC's goal is to help keep pregnant women, breastfeeding moms, and children younger than age 5 healthy. Since Grow to Share benefits extend to the entire family, our work helps babies, moms, dads, grandparents, older children and teens realize the benefits of fresh, healthy produce. This growing season, we were able to feed 956 individuals.

COMMUNITY IMPACTS

The Grow to Share program is greatly appreciated by the community. In the words of one participant, "Receiving locally grown vegetables has been a tremendous help in having my daughter reach her eating solid foods goals! It's been helpful financially as well so I'm very grateful for this program."

REDUCING FOOD WASTE

With the addition of HC3's Bilingual Program Coordinator, we were able to continue our efforts on helping families join HC3's free Food Scrap program. Those who were interested could enroll onsite and get a free food scrap bucket.
